NOTE : A school bus being used for a school related activity can have either an SB or a BY plate on it. A school bus entering an adjoining state can display either plate.

NOTE : A school bus driver crossing a state line MUST have their medical card in possession.

NOTE : Within 100 air miles of the bus terminal, the driver is not required to complete a logbook provided that there are time records maintained at the bus garage (which we all do). The driver must start and end at the same location and must not exceed 12 hours.

NOTE : School buses registered by the state of Wisconsin are not permitted to pull trailers. This is a state law but because we are Minnesota registered, we fall under federal guidelines and therefore buses registered in the state of Minnesota, CAN pull a trailer.

NOTE : School buses travelling into South Dakota are required to obtain a Fuel Tax Permit prior to entering the state. A Fuel Tax Permit can be purchased for \$20 by calling the Interstate 90 South Dakota Scale at (605) 757-6406 or the South Dakota Permit Center at (605) 698-3925. Permits can be emailed or faxed. The permit is a one-time use and is void as soon as the bus crosses back into Minnesota.

NOTE : Any bus (SB or BY) crossing into any of the adjoining states must display an MIP inspection sticker. This is the same inspection and sticker displayed on all of our charter buses. Contact any of our Certified Inspectors : Tim Larson, John Michels or John Brandt, for this inspection.
